Tobacco Use Amongst Teenagers

- People who start smoking at an early age are more likely to develop a severe addiction to nicotine than those who start at a later age.
- Every day, almost 2,500 children under 18 years of age try their first cigarette, and more than 400 of them will become new, regular daily smokers. Half of them will ultimately die from their habit.
- If current tobacco use patterns persist, an estimated 5.6 million of today's youth under age 18 eventually will die prematurely from a smoking-related disease.

Born in the nic(otine) of time: California legislators move to ban tobacco products for Gen-Z and beyond



The California Legislature will soon consider Assembly Bill 935 which would ban the sale of tobacco products to anyone born after January 1, 2007. As the state prohibits the sale of flavored tobacco products and maintains a legal smoking age of 21 years old the market is already over regulated.




